LEAD PA/DE 2020 - Leadership Program for High School Students

LEAD is a Leadership Program by Sewa International for High School students. It introduces socially conscious leadership in youngsters. It provides a platform for the participants to serve the greater community and experience the joy of giving.

Hereby we invite applications for LEAD PA/DE 2020 volunteer program. A great opportunity to meet socially aware community leaders, develop leadership, teamwork and organizational skills, serve community and have fun along the way besides achieving Sewa recognition and USA President's award.

Information session: 10 am to noon on March 1st 2020 at West Whiteland Township Building (101 Commerce Dr, Exton, PA 19341).

Project location: Exton/West Chester PA Area (most activities are around Exton)

Duration: Around seven months (March 2020 to October 2020). Minimum 100 hours are required to fulfill the LEAD program requirements. The hours spent on the LEAD program are also used to secure The President's Volunteer Service Award. Minimum 100 hours are needed for 16+ age and 50 hours for below 16 to secure The President's Volunteer Award (<https://www.presidentialserviceawards.gov/>). Project and Event based activities that will be coordinated by youth members.

Additional Information:

- Preference will be given to the youth with commitment from parents/friends to lead some events (minimum 3 events). Typical events are 3-4 hours during a weekend.
- All the hours to be fulfilled have to be Sewa initiated activities. We cannot include the hours served outside the Sewa activities.
- Every youth member is required to lead a fundraising event as part of the curriculum to raise a minimum of \$100 (not from parents) to support the projects in India and other countries. The program will help the youth members in designing such a fundraising based on their interest and ideas.

- There will be 4 hour activities during alternate Sundays in addition to the various summer and fall activities. The program provides opportunity for minimum 130 hours as some students may not be able to attend all the events.

General Eligibility: High School Students (in or incoming), i.e, current 8th, 9th, 10th and 11th graders. Only students who are sincerely committed to the Sewa mission should apply.

Program Fee: \$100 / candidate. To pay the costs of the program.
